Report for the Month of January, 2020

1. Central Office

(i) Kala Sibiram, a residential winter camp was organized at Kalakshetra Foundation from 7th January to 14th January 2020. Dance students from various parts of India and abroad took part in the camp. In all we had 35 participants. They were trained by Kalakshetra senior teachers and scholars. Daily programs started at 6 AM with Yoga sessions and the programs ended 4.30 pm followed by presentation/performance. Other than dance sessions, the junior participants were introduced to the world of Kalamkari, Pottery, Storytelling, Bhajans, Slokas and Heritage. The senior participants had experienced Laya, Abhinaya, Art and Heritage classes in addition to dance sessions. The week-long camp included guided tour to Mylapore Kapaleeswarar temple on one evening and a full day guided tour to Mamallapuram & Dhakshinachitra. The camp ended with performance by all the participants.

Kalakshetra Foundation had earned a revenue of about Rs.16 Lakhs as fees from the participants.

(ii) Indo-Korean Ceramic Residency and Exhibition

Inko Centre in association with Clayarch Gimhae Museum-Korea, Kalakshetra Foundation and Dakshinachitra organized 'Earth Matters- Edition 3' on 19th January 2020 at Visual Art Department, Kalakshetra Foundation. This is a unique Indo-Korean ceramic residency project which has brought together 8 ceramic artists - 4 each from India and Korea. The residency is for five weeks.
